

PUBLIC NOTICE

The CITY OF O'DONNELL water system PWS ID 1530001 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This/these violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period(s) for first quarter 2025.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: **this is a paperwork/report submission violation only.** Daily monitoring of residuals was conducted as required, however, the quarterly report was not submitted to TCEQ. This issue is being resolved by implementing a calendar notification to multiple staff members to ensure the report is submitted in a timely manner.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
